From Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky Airport

Take Interstate 275 East to Interstate 71/Interstate 75 North. Stay in the far right lane and proceed to I-71 North. Exit onto 2nd Street and turn left onto Vine St. The hotel is located 2 ½ blocks ahead on the right between 4th and 5th streets. Access the parking garage via Vine St.

DIRECTIONS, continued

From East

Take Interstate 275 South to Interstate 471 North. Proceed to the 3rd Street exit. Continue on 3rd St. to Vine St. Turn right onto Vine. The hotel is located 1 ½ blocks ahead on the right between 4th and 5th streets. Access the parking garage via Vine St.

From North (taking I-75 South)

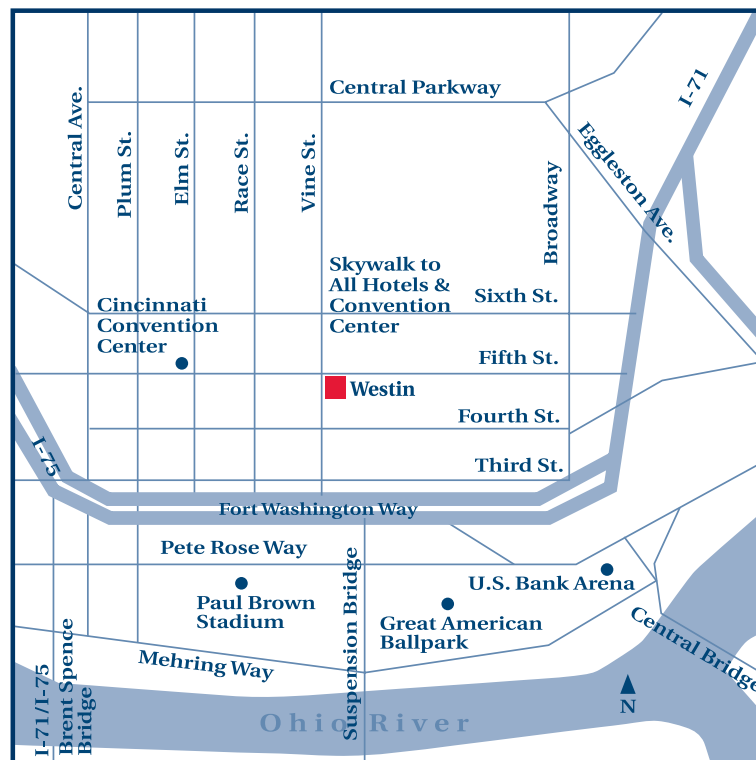
Take Interstate 75 South to the 7th Street Exit. Proceed 6 blocks on 7th Street and turn right onto Walnut. Continue 3 blocks and turn right onto 4th Street. Continue on 4th Street for one block and turn right onto Vine. The hotel is on the right between 4th and 5th streets. Access the parking garage via Vine St.

From North (taking I-71 South)

Take Interstate 71 South and stay in the far left lane to the 3rd Street Exit. Proceed 4 blocks on 3rd Street and turn right onto Vine Street. The hotel is located 1 ½ blocks ahead on the right between 4th and 5th streets. Access the parking garage via Vine Street.

From West

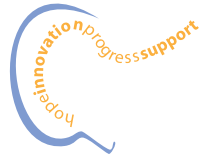
